



## **Raffle to win a Flymap F7 at the Flying Show 2009**

Participation in the Flymap raffle costs £1 per raffle ticket. Tickets may be bought at the BMAA stand (no. 29) at the Flying Show.

There are no restrictions to the number of entries one person can make.

Monies raised by the Flymap raffle will go to the BMAA Fighting Fund whose aim is to help keep airfields open and further the cause of microlighting whenever it is threatened.

Payment for participation in the raffle can only be in cash.

No responsibility is taken for lost raffle tickets.

Closing date for the sale of raffle ticket payment is 16:00 29th November 2009. Tickets received after this time may not be entered in the draw.

The raffle draw will take place at 16:00 on 29th November 2009 on the BMAA stand at the Flying Show.

The winner is the first ticket drawn. In the event of a lost ticket, or that the owner of the first ticket cannot be contacted within 21 days despite the best efforts of the Flying Show staff, a list of tickets drawn 2, 3, 4 and 5 shall be maintained and the prize shall be offered in turn to those ticket holders.

The result of the raffle draw is final. No correspondence will be entered into.

The Flymap raffle is open to all Flying Show visitors, exhibitors and staff over the age of 16. The tickets may not be sold to, or by, a person under 16 years of age.

Winners will be notified by email or telephone. Their details may be used on the BMAA website and in BMAA's magazine Microlight Flying.
